Things you can do to inspire and support the public's desire to see more healing:

1. Pray to be more aware of the public's demand and desire to find healing
2. Answer someone's questions about Christian Science
3. Share a personal testimony of healing
4. Share a copy of Science and Health or a Committee blog via social media

SCIENCE AND HEALTH

Questions to consider:

1. Is my demand for Science and Health increasing?
2. What evidence am I seeing that public demand is increasing?
3. How can I meet this demand?

ANSWERING QUESTIONS

"If someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it" (I Pet 3:15 NLT).

Three key questions you might be asked:

1. What is Christian Science? Or, Why are you a Christian Scientist?
2. Why don't you go to doctors?
3. What is prayer?

Three tips for answering questions:

1. Speak from your own experience (e.g. "I have found..." vs. "Christian Scientists believe...")
2. Feel free to ask questions yourself
3. Continue to nurture a willingness to answer someone's questions
